Call to artist – C-Net Workshops

Fixed Term: Seven workshops between April and August 2018

Jaywick Martello Tower is looking for a freelance artist to lead C-Net creative workshops.

C-Net is part of our successful community programme and is a series of free workshops for young people aged between 8 and 15 years old that take place on Tuesdays in the Easter and Summer holidays at Jaywick Martello Tower. C-Net has been running since 2010. Each workshop runs from 10am until 1pm for up to 15 young people. The Tower is looking for an artist to lead all seven sessions, each workshop looking at a different art form or idea to inspire participants.

The work will entail;

- Leading a series of creative workshops inspired by the themes of Jaywick Martello Tower, community, heritage and environment.
- Managing materials budget
- Documenting workshops
- Reporting to the Tower Manager

Applicants must be self-employed with liability insurance of £5 million and have a DBS check for safeguarding policy.

Context:

Jaywick Martello Tower is a unique arts, heritage and community space. The Tower was built during the Napoleonic War as part of a system of defences along the south east coast. It is now classified as a scheduled ancient monument and a grade two listed building. The Tower plays a pivotal role within the local community and surrounding areas of Jaywick Sands and is a key tourist destination, attracting an average of 8,000 visitors per year. The Tower delivers a programme of exhibitions, workshops, talks and events.
