ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Who can enter?

The Jaywick Martello Tower Coastal Open is open to anyone of any age who lives in the Tendring area or Essex based artists who use the Tendring coastal area as inspiration. People can enter as a group or as individuals.

How many artworks can I enter?

Maximum of two artworks in any medium per entry. If you submitted work in previous Coastal Open exhibitions then the same work cannot be submitted for the 2016 Open.

How much does it cost?

An entrance fee of £2 per artwork (to cover exhibition and publicity costs).

How will work be selected?

Work will be checked by a panel to ensure that the themes of Community, Environment and Heritage are adhered to.

Is my work insured?

Participants will have to provide their own insurance (if required) for individual artworks.

What else do I have to do?

If you would like to offer half a day stewarding or conduct a workshop or demonstration then please tick on the form which one you would like to do and preferred dates.

What if my work is for sale?

The Coastal Open organisers can sell artworks but with participants' permission are also able to pass on contact details. All artworks must be on display throughout the whole exhibition. A 10% commission is taken for any work sold during the exhibition.

Is my artwork too big?

Size of artworks will be restricted to allow space for maximum number of artworks to be included in the exhibition. Maximum size of 2D artworks is A1. For any 3D work exhibitors should use consideration in relation to other artists. 2D work must be already strung or have mirror plates attached.

Will my artwork be photographed?

Participants must agree as a condition of entry into the exhibition that all artworks are allowed to be photographed for documentation and publicity purposes.

What will happen to my work after the exhibition?

Exhibitors will be required to collect their artwork on **Tuesday 1st November 2016**.

Please note there will be no facilities for storage if artworks are not collected within a month then they will be disposed of.
