Call to artist – Family Drop in Workshops

Rate of pay: Include your fee costs within the proposal. Fee must include all travel and expenditure.

Material Budget: Material budget to be supplied with proposal.

Jaywick Martello Tower is looking for freelance artists to lead family drop in workshops suitable for all ages.

You may apply for one or as many of the drop in workshops that you have ideas for. Each workshop must be unique and inspire participants.

The work will entail;

- Leading one off creative workshops inspired by the themes of Jaywick Martello Tower, community, heritage and environment
- Managing materials budget
- Documenting workshops
- Reporting to the Tower Manager

Applicants must be self-employed with liability insurance of £5 million and have a DBS check for safeguarding policy.

Context:

Jaywick Martello Tower is a unique arts, heritage and community space. The Tower was built during the Napoleonic War as part of a system of defences along the south east coast. It is now classified as a scheduled ancient monument and a grade two listed building. The Tower plays a pivotal role within the local community and surrounding areas of Jaywick Sands and is a key tourist destination, attracting an average of 8,000 visitors per year. The Tower delivers a programme of exhibitions, workshops, talks and events.
